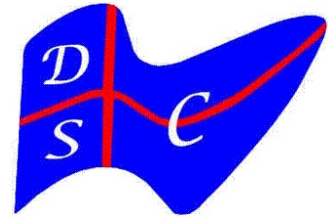

Notice of Race Spring 2008 to Winter 2009

We are pleased to invite you to participate in our racing and activities for the forthcoming season. This Notice of Race governs three separate point score series during the year, namely a Summer Twilight series on Tuesday evenings, a Summer series and a Winter series, both sailed on alternate Sundays.

1. Rules

All races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008* (RRS), the Prescriptions and Special Regulations of the Australian Yachting Federation (AYF), The Boating (Safety and Equipment) Regulations NSW, all as amended by the Sailing Instructions and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Changes to these rules

Alterations and amendments to these rules may be made from time to time by the Race Committee. Notice of any such alterations or amendments will be placed on the notice board in the Sailors Bar. The Yacht Division Committee of DSC is the Race Committee for the purposes of RRS 88.1.

3. Eligibility and Entry

Yachts must enter by sending a completed Entry Form by mail (PO Box 582, Drummoyne, NSW, 2047) or in person together with the Race Entry Fee to the Race Committee no later than 10 days prior to commencement of racing. All skippers must be current members of DSC and YA to be eligible for competition.

No results will be recorded for entries not received by the Race Committee 10 days prior to racing. Yachts wishing to enter a specific race on a casual basis may do so by submitting to the race committee a completed Entry Form and the required Fee prior to the race. Casual entries do not score points and are not eligible for the weekly prize.

Fixed keel yachts must comply with Category 7 safety requirements of the AYF. All other yachts must comply with Category 6 safety requirements of the AYF and YA Special Regulations Part 1 Section 3.04 or 3.05 as appropriate.

It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure that their vessel complies with these requirements.

All those taking part in DSC races or events do so at their own risk and responsibility. Refer RRS Fundamental Rule 4.

The DSC is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted or the sufficiency or adequacy of its equipment.

The DSC is not responsible for any damage or injury either ashore or afloat or at sea either to persons or boats that might participate in a race or other organised events. The Drummoyne Sailing Club does not hold insurance to cover participants in aquatic events.

4. Fee Structure

Yacht Section Membership including entry fees for Twilight, Summer and Winter point Score \$200.00

Individual Yacht Section membership \$ 20.00

Casual Race entry fee \$ 20.00

Membership after 1 April 2009 including entry fees for Winter point score \$ 80.00

5. Schedule of Races

The schedule of races shall be as described in the sailing instructions.

8. Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be distributed once an entry is accepted. They will also be available at our web site: www.drummoynesailingclub.com.au

9. Courses

The courses shall be as described in the sailing instructions.

10. Scoring

The scoring system shall be as described in the sailing instructions.

11. Race Results and Prizes

The provisional results of each race will be announced at the Drummoyne Sailing Club after each race at the discretion of the race committee. Prizes may be given to those present. Results may also be available at www.drummoynesailingclub.com.au by following the links.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in these races entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the races.

13. Series Presentations

The Presentation for the Winter Series will be held after the last Winter Series race at Drummoyne Sailing Club. Recognition for placings in this series may also be given at the Summer and Twilight Series presentation night.

The Presentation for Summer and Twilight Series has been scheduled for the evening of Saturday 2 May 2009. Please note it in your diaries.

14. Dispensation

The Yachting Association of NSW granted a dispensation to RRS 46 and 55 to Drummoyne Sailing Club Yacht Section on 18 August 2006 for twilight races.

15. Insurance

All boats must have comprehensive insurance covering racing and Public Liability to a minimum of AUD10 Million for the duration of these races.
